

## **VEHICLE INTERRUPTION ON CLARK KERR CAMPUS SPORTS LANE STARTING SEPT 16**

Work to install a new water line below Sports Lane on the Clark Kerr Campus is scheduled to begin Sept. 16. Construction for the first phase of work will start in the road adjacent to Buildings 7 and 9 and Redwood Gardens and go to the intersection near the skateboard park. From Sept 16 to approximately Oct 12, that section of Sports Lane will be closed to regular vehicle traffic from 8am – 4pm weekdays. Plans have been made to provide Redwood Gardens residents and staff access to their parking lots, and access to other parking at residences on the south side of the campus will be maintained. Visitors to the Clark Kerr Campus should enter and exit on Sports Lane at Dwight Way, as exiting on Derby Street will not be allowed as work is underway. Flaggers will direct traffic during work hours. After hours (evenings and weekends) any trenches will be covered with steel plates and vehicles will be able to use the road. Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

The second phase of the water line installation will move north along Sports Lane, east of the skateboard park and tennis courts to the roadway on the north side of Building 23. It is expected to begin in mid-October and take four weeks to complete. The project team is working to minimize the impact of this phase of work on Clark Kerr Campus vehicle traffic; details of the traffic plan will be sent as soon as they are confirmed.

This new water line will provide water for fire hydrants and emergency response lines to the whole residential campus. Our apologies for any inconvenience this temporary road closure creates. Please follow the direction of flaggers and other project personnel who may need to direct traffic.
